

The Colonial Experience Poster

You are an 18-century English reporter/artist who has been sent to the colonies to learn about colonial America. While in America, you kept notes to record your thoughts and impressions of the place, its people, and their culture. Your boss back in England wants you to use the information you have gathered on the colonial culture and make an informational poster so that the people of England will better understand what life is like in colonial America.

1. You must have a title for your poster.
2. You should have at least ONE picture that represents each of your topics.
3. You need to write one paragraph (at least five sentences) about each topic. Each topic must have a title.
4. Your poster should be neat and colorful.

*****IN ADDITION**, you must report on **TWO** different colonies. Describe the land and environment, the government as well as freedoms and slavery. You must include either pictures or maps to represent your colonies.
